2 Reports of the work of the Council during 2009/10. Reports were presented and received on the work of the Council during 2009/10 as attached to these minutes.

3 Questions from electors.

Mrs G Fisher complained that the doors of the Village Hall had been locked at the time of the commencement of the meeting, preventing entry by some members of the public. It was noted this was necessitated by the presence of children within the building at the time although the matter would be revisited.

(Cllr D Hughes, as Chairman of the Guilden Sutton Community Association, informed a subsequent meeting of the Parish Council that an improved bell system was to be installed.)

Reference was made to the access to the Millennium Greenway via Garners Lane. A Member informed it was hoped it would be possible for an asphalt surface to be laid as the stone surface was a barrier for people with pushchairs. The issue would be referred to the Greenway Project Officer.

Cllr Paterson referred to the closure of the Methodist Church in the early Autumn and to correspondence in connection with its possible opening as a community centre.

Cllr Moulton thanked the Council for its hard work during the year. Cllr Fisher thanked the Clerk for the preparation of the annual reports to which the Clerk responded.

Closing the Meeting, the Chairman thanked members of the public for their attendance.
