



WW1 BATTLE IS OVER BEACON

For Remembrance on 11th November 2018

Guilden Sutton Parish Council are delighted to inform the residents that they intend to participate in the commemorative lighting of a beacon as part of the countrywide recognition of the fallen during the First World War.

The event will take place at the beacon near the Rugby Club, in the evening.

Lighting of the Beacon will be 7pm, preceded by a Prayer from Heather.

It is hoped to have the Last Post sounded at 6.55pm.

Hare Lane will be closed from 6.30 – 8.30pm, and so access to parking at the Rugby Club in this time will be via the A51

It is hoped to have the Police in attendance, but four Parish Council Marshalls will be required for the safety of those attending.

Raewyn Bailey has been invited to light the beacon as a tribute to her husband Brian who was very keen to see the Beacon lit on other occasions.
